



Lulu Auditions FAQ

Where will the auditions take place?

Auditions will take place on Wednesday, Nov. 7, from 10:00 AM to noon at the E. Claire Raley Studios for the Performing Arts (also known as CLARA), 2420 N Street, Sacramento, CA 95816

Where do I go when I arrive?

Please enter CLARA via the parking lot entrance, located at O Street between 24th and 25th Streets. Park in the lot between the red brick building and beige building. Go through the brick archway, enter through the green doors and make a left to the audition area, which is the Capital Stage Rehearsal Studio on the first floor. Please note that about half the parking spaces in the lot are reserved for guests of specific CLARA tenants – please respect these, and park in a non-reserved space. There is also free two-hour parking on the city streets around CLARA. If you park on the street, it is still best to enter CLARA through the parking lot entrance, as noted above. Please check in with a Broadway Sacramento staff member upon arrival.

How early do I need to arrive prior to my scheduled audition?

Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to the audition session time for which you signed up. To sign up, **please [CLICK HERE](#)**.

What should my child wear?

The character's costume is simple denim with a t-shirt, so participants can wear whatever makes them comfortable. The audition will require running; therefore, children should wear appropriate shoes to run in safely.

What do we need to bring?

Please bring a current photo and resume, if available. When your audition time is confirmed, you will also receive several documents to review and sign and bring to the audition with you.

Do I get to watch my child audition?

Children will be brought into the audition room with Broadway Sacramento staff and parents will be asked to wait outside for the 5-minute audition.

How long will the audition take?

Each audition is expected to take approximately 5 minutes, however it may take some time to get to your child. Please be prepared to stay at the audition for approximately 1 hour.

Who decides which actresses will be cast?

All casting decisions are made by the company representing WAITRESS.

If my child is cast, what is the expectation?

Your child should be available Dec. 27, 2018 to Jan. 5, 2019 for performances of *Waitress* at Community Center Theater, 1301 L Street, Sacramento, CA 95814. The part appears in the finale so children should be prepared to be at the theater until at least 2 ½ hours after the performance begins. ([CLICK HERE](#) for performance schedule.) Additional information will be provided to those selected by the company of WAITRESS.

What if my child cannot make one of the scheduled performances but would still like to audition?

Each actress should be prepared to step in at any of the scheduled performances. Any conflicts should be disclosed at the audition.

When will we be notified of casting?

The production office will contact the parent or guardian by phone or email within two weeks after the audition. The names will also be announced on the Broadway Sacramento Facebook page and website.
