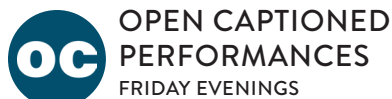




BROADWAY AT MUSIC CIRCUS 2023 ACCESSIBLE ARTS

**OPEN CAPTIONED
PERFORMANCES**
FRIDAY EVENINGS

Open captioning provides patrons who are deaf or hard of hearing with a text display of the dialogue and lyrics of the performance. Patrons requesting this service will be seated in view of a screen displaying the captions in real time.



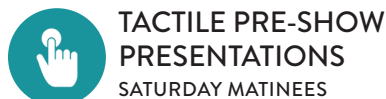
**SIGN INTERPRETED

American Sign Language-interpreted performances are offered for patrons who are deaf or hard of hearing. Patrons requesting this service will be seated in view of an interpreter.



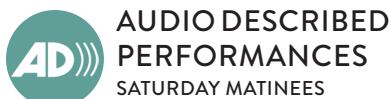
**HEARING ASSISTIVE

Hearing assistive devices are available for loan prior to each performance. A valid driver's license or other form of ID is required for deposit.



**TACTILE PRE-SHOW
PRESENTATIONS**

Tactile pre-show presentations offer patrons who are blind and visually impaired an opportunity for close-up, hands on interaction with the costumes and props from the show, accompanied by detailed descriptions from members of the production team.



**AUDIO DESCRIBED

Audio description provides patrons who are blind or visually impaired with an objective and concise description of the action and key visual elements on stage, in between dialogue and/or music. Patrons requesting this service can borrow a listening device, and are encouraged to arrive early to hear additional information about the show.

Detailed ADA parking information is available on our website. Passenger drop-off is located on 15th Street between G and H street.



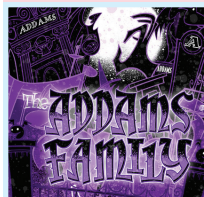
