BE KIND TO THE THEATRE STAFF

Our ushers and staff are here to help you have a fun, safe visit. Please listen to their instructions and be kind—they're part of the team that makes the show happen!



PHONES OFF, PLEASE!

Phones can glow, buzz, or make noises that distract the performers and everyone around you. Before the show starts, please turn your phone completely off and keep it put away until the end.



NO PICTURES OR RECORDING

Taking pictures, videos or sound recordings during the show isn't allowed. It can bother the performers and it's also against theatre rules. Enjoy the moment with your eyes and ears instead!



REMAIN QUIET DURING THE SHOW

Laughing and clapping are great! But talking, singing along, whispering to friends or opening noisy wrappers can make it hard for others to enjoy the performance. Save your comments for intermission or after the show.



STAY IN YOUR SEAT

Try to use the restroom and buy snacks before the show starts or during intermission. Getting up while the show is happening can distract other audience members and you might have to wait to be let back in.



WHEN DO I CLAP?

At most shows, it's normal to clap after a song or a special solo. Many people also clap at the very end when the cast comes out to take their bows. If you really love a performance, it's okay to stand up and cheer!
